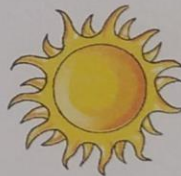

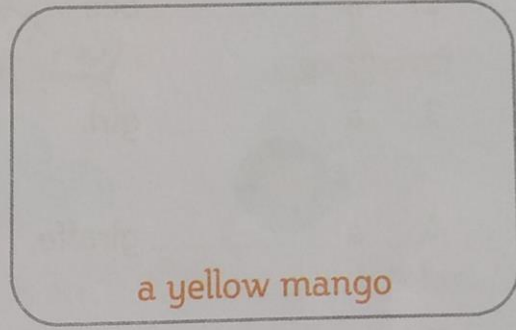
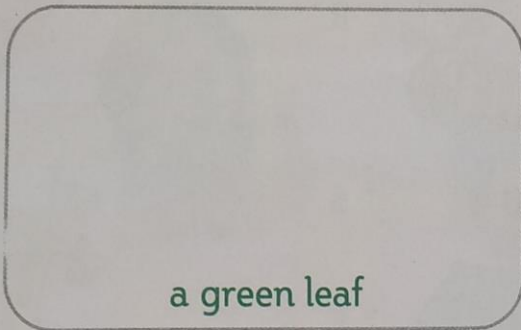


## Describing Words

Examples: • **blue** sky • **round** ball • **tall** tree

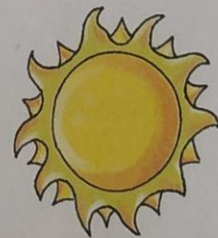
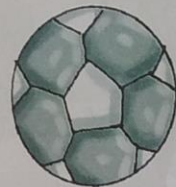

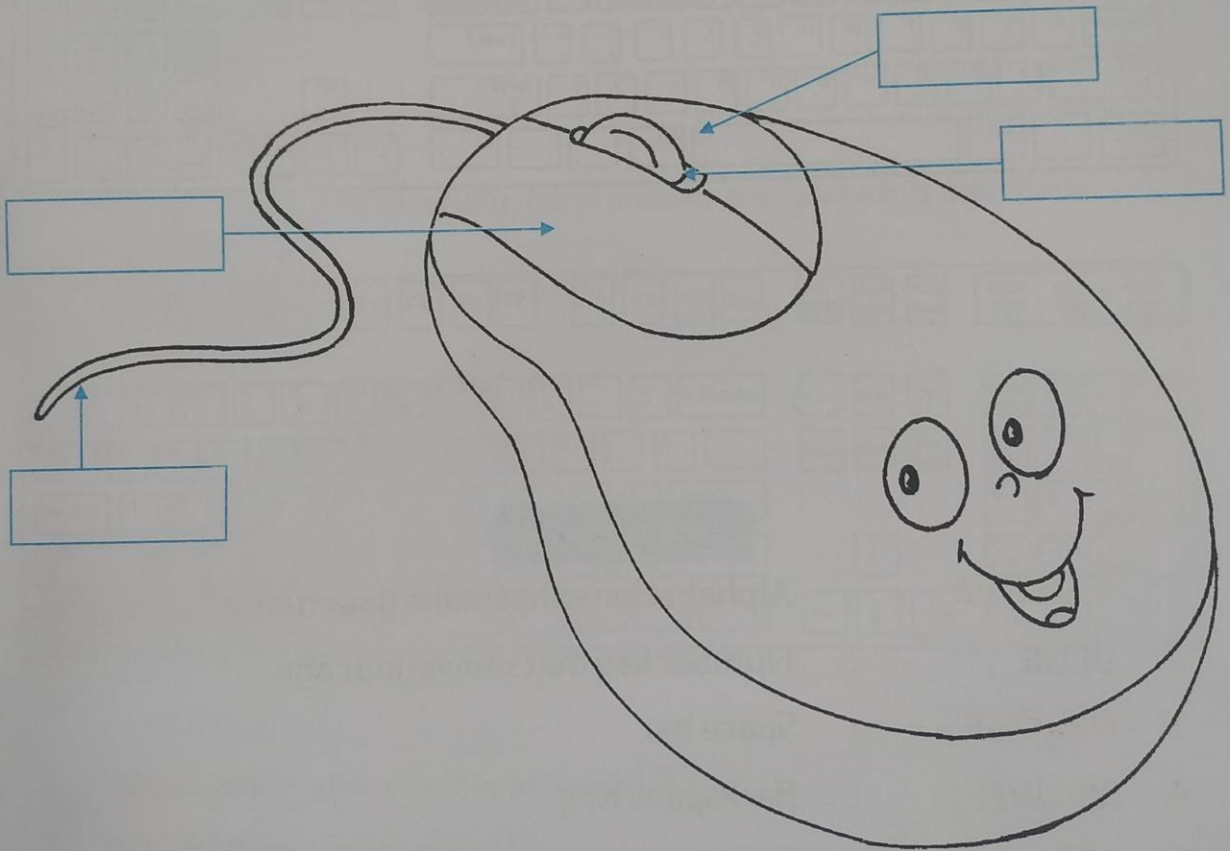
